pastors. We look forward to dynamic and informative sessions on the most current issues facing our nation.

The Briefing will be held at the Hyatt Regency on Capitol Hill, located at 400 New Jersey Avenue, NW (202-737-1234). A preliminary agenda is enclosed for your reference. Please note that registration is from 2:00 – 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 20, in the Regency Ballroom Foyer located on the lower Ballroom level of the Hyatt. You must register prior to attending any activities that evening. A reception in the Regency Ballroom from 4:00 – 6:00 p.m. begins the Briefing. We have scheduled four spiritual heritage tours of the Capitol that evening led by David Barton, President of Wallbuilders, and his associate, Rick Green—two tours from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. and two from 8:00 – 10:00 p.m. (Note: Buses will depart the Hyatt at 5:30 p.m. for the 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. tours. You will receive information at registration regarding your tour time. We will do our best to accommodate any pastors who may currently be on the waiting list for the Capitol tour.) Also that evening, those going on the Capitol tour can go to FRC for a tour of the headquarters and hear about the scope of our ministry.

Please refer to the enclosed schedule for a list of topics and speakers which include Senator Jim DeMint, Congressman Mike Pence, Dr. Ergun Caner, former Congressman Bob McEwen, Father Frank Pavone, David Barton, Bishop Harry Jackson, Tony Perkins, Ken Ham, Robert Stearns, Pastor Miles McPherson, Pastor Larry Stockstill, Anne Graham Lotz and a panel with Dr. Barrett Duke and FRC policy experts. Dr. Henry Blackaby will lead a time of commissioning at the closing luncheon on Friday. Please remember to book your return flight late enough on Friday so that you are able to hear Dr. Blackaby's charge to the Watchmen.

In addition to a great line-up of speakers, we are offering free time Thursday afternoon during which you may visit your state's congressional delegation or engage in a prayer walk. Please note that you are responsible for setting up your own appointment time with your Representative or Senator(s). FRC will provide bus transportation to the Hill at 1:00 p.m. and back to the Hyatt at 3:30 p.m. You may call your members' scheduling secretaries or fax a letter of request to their attention as soon as possible and follow up by phone. If you have not made these arrangements, a sample letter requesting an appointment is enclosed. When calling, please refer to Family Research Council's Pastors' Briefing so that the scheduler can arrange for one meeting time with any other pastors from the Briefing who are requesting appointments. You can reach your Congressman and Senators by calling the Capitol Hill switchboard at 202-224-3121.

If requested, we have reserved a room for you at the Hyatt Regency Capitol Hill, 400 New Jersey Avenue, NW. Check in is at 3:00 p.m. If you do not receive your confirmation number via e-mail from the Hyatt Regency, please call our Events Staff at 1-800-225-4008 to obtain your confirmation number. As you know, FRC has funding to cover your lodging for May 20 and 21 as well as event-related meals.
